In 1942, the first nuclear chain reaction was achieved by Enrico Fermi and his team at the University of Chicago.

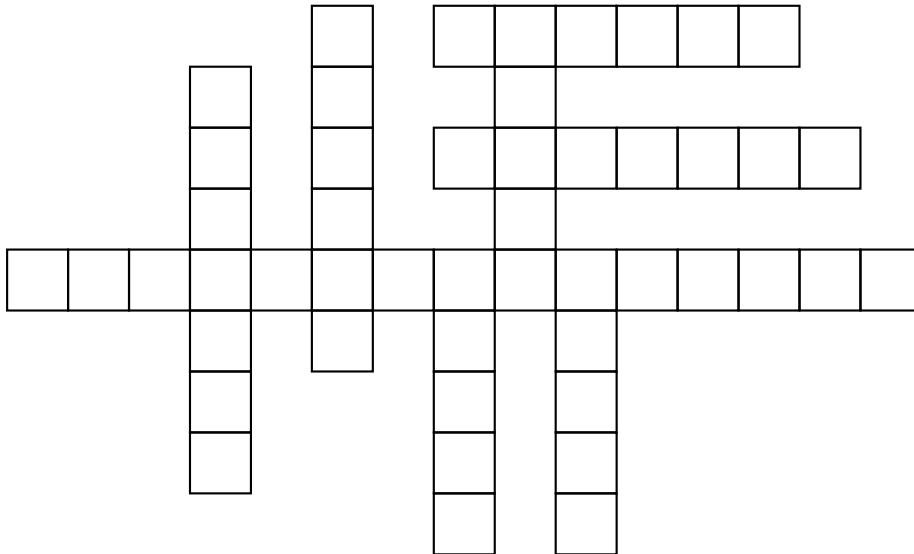
In 1982 the first artificial heart was implanted successfully.
