mass producing different types and flavors of cream cheese, but recipes to add cream cheese to. On the other hand, brownies didn't come around until the 1800s when socialite Bertha Palmer requested a cake like dessert for the ladies attending the World's

Columbian Exposition. The chef created a smaller, denser, and fudgier cake for the event, but the term brownie wasn't used until the first recipe appeared in Fannie Farmer's Boston Cooking School Book in 1906. Cream cheese was added to brownies in a recipe that appeared in a New York City cookbook in 1907. Over time, the recipe has evolved, adding fruits and nuts to elevate the flavors and textures.

Bakeries began creating their own spins on the classic recipe, not only with cream cheese but also adding different things to brownies like peanut butter, marshmallow, and caramel. Boxed brownie mixes completely changed the dessert game, with tons of different flavors and types of brownie. Pillsbury released a cream cheese brownie boxed mix that still can be found in grocery stores today.

Although, creating your own fudgy brownies and making them your own with your own toppings and fillings is way more fun! Observation of this day can be so sweet! Trying tons of different bakeries' cream cheese brownies to find your favorite, trying different spins on the treat like cream cheese brownie ice cream. Just make sure you don't go into a sugar coma!

Interesting Fact

On this day in 1989, Miami Vice premiered its 100th episode. Miami Vice is an American crime drama television series starring Don Johnson and Phillip Michael Thomas as two undercover detectives. The show drew on popular 80's culture, focusing on the fashion, music, and cars. The idea began as a movie idea but was then sold to NBC as a weekly drama in 1983. The two hour pilot was first named Gold Coast but was quickly changed to Miami Vice once the location switched from Los Angeles and focused on South Florida. Most episodes pertained to drug trafficking or prostitution, usually ending with an intense gun battle. Ratings for the show varied over the years, with the first season not even in the top 30, the second season at spot 9, the third season at spot 26, and the last two seasons not in the top 30. After season 4's low ratings, the studio almost ordered for the 5th and final season to be a shortened season with a two hour finale, but soon changed tact and decided to create a full final season for the show. The show ran for five seasons with 136 episodes.
