the hazelnut spread with a chocolatey finish. In the early 1800s, a hazelnut confection with chocolate called gianduja was popular in Turin, Italy. During this time, there was a shortage of cocoa so hazelnuts were added to stretch the chocolate. Pietro Ferrero sold big

blocks of this treat in his bakery in Alba, Italy. He then

developed a creamier version that was sold in a loaf type shape and was meant to be spreadable. It was so popular that his son decided to change the original recipe to be even more spreadable, then started selling Nutella by its new name and by the jar. This was immediately

successful, becoming popular across Europe and by the mid 1980s, the Ferrero family was shipping Nutella to United States stores. World Nutella Day was named in 2007 so Nutella enthusiasts could celebrate their love of the spread on a special day. For Nutella's 40th anniversary, in Gelsenkirchen, Germany around 28,000 chefs participated in creating the world's largest continental breakfast using Nutella as the

special ingredient. Ten years later, the 50 year celebration took place in ten different countries. In 2017, the first Nutella Café opened up in Chicago, specializing in Nutella filled and flavored beverages and bakery items. The popularity of Nutella has continued across the world, with the company creating new ways to incorporate the chocolatey hazelnut spread into tasty treats. Observance of this day can

come in so many tasty ways. using Nutella on different kinds of baked goods like croissants, cookies, and staples like pancakes and crepes, which you can find recipes for on Nutella's website. You could even try your hand at making your own kind of hazelnut spread, pasting hazelnuts in a food processor and adding melted chocolate, salt, and vanilla.

Interesting Fact

On this day in 1921, musician Joni Mitchell was inducted into the Canadian Music Hall of Fame. She was born on November 7th, 1943 in Fort MacLeod, Alberta in Canada. She contracted polio at age nine and was hospitalized for weeks but recovered. At age 11, her family moved to Saskatoon where she considered to be her hometown. She developed her artistic skills, focusing on painting but also learned classic piano, poetry, dancing, and singing. Her mother didn't want her to play guitar due to their hillbilly associations, so she started with ukelele. She eventually taught herself guitar and started singing and performing with a group of friends and started performing in coffee shops and a local hotel. After the birth of her daughter in 1964, Joni started traveling and left Canada for the first time to perform with her soon to be husband Chuck Mitchell. She began playing and composing songs in alternate tunings due to the weakened state of her left hand from polio, and after her divorce she once again performed solo. In 1967, she was discovered in a club that she often performed in and signed a contract with Reprise. Thus began her successful career, being named the 72nd greatest guitar player of all time in Rolling Stone.
